

Game Time Sweepstakes for Financial Professionals



Official Rules

These are the Official Rules for the Game Time Sweepstakes for Financial Professionals ("Sweepstakes"). The Sweepstakes is sponsored by Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company ("Nationwide"), One Nationwide Plaza, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

No purchase is necessary to enter or win. Making a purchase will not increase the odds of winning.

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. Open to current financial professional prospects licensed with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA) or registered through Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) who have never sold a Nationwide Financial Life, Annuity or Retirement Solutions product or service, who are legal residents of the contiguous United States and the District of Columbia who (a) are 18 years of age or have reached the age of majority in their residential jurisdiction at the time of entry, whichever is greater, and (b) is legally able to work in the United States. Excludes any Web Personalization Digitally Identified FP within the last 365 days or identified via Desktop AND not identified via Tablet or Mobile. Financial professionals with Ameriprise, Edward Jones, Fidelity, Hantz, Merrill Lynch, Morgan Stanley, Raymond James, UBS and WFG, Corebridge/VALIC are excluded. Firm restrictions and exclusions apply. Eligible winner must be with a firm that has selling agreements with Nationwide for Annuities, Life, and Retirement Solutions.
- 1.2. **Nationwide Excluded.** Employees and agents of Nationwide, its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and any entity involved in the development, production, implementation, administration or fulfillment of the Promotion (collectively referred to as "Promotion Entities") and their immediate family members and/or those living in the same household of such persons, whether related or not, are not eligible to enter the Promotion.
- 1.3. **No Other Sponsorship.**

2. How to Enter.

2.1. Promotion Period.

The Sweepstakes will run from September 14, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. ET, to October 11, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. ET ("Promotion Period").

2.2. Entry.

To enter, visit marketing.nationwide.com/gametimesweepstakes and complete the brief form, including your CRD# or IARD#. All eligible entries in the prize drawing have an equal chance of winning. The odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received during the Sweepstakes Period.

2.3. Restrictions.

Limit one (1) entry during the Promotion Period. Nationwide will disqualify anyone found to have submitted multiple entries. In addition, Nationwide will not consider ineligible, illegible or incomplete submissions on the entry form or through postings on private LinkedIn, Facebook or Instagram pages.

2.4. Conditions.

Entrants agree to be bound by the Official Rules and the decisions of Nationwide, which are final and binding on all matters relating to the Sweepstakes. Nationwide is not responsible for any typographical or other errors in printing the offer, administration of the Sweepstakes or the announcement of the prizes, or for lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or illegal entries.

2.5. Participant's Consent.

Entry constitutes consent to participate in Promotions and for Nationwide to obtain, use and transfer the entrant's photo for internal Promotion administration purposes. By participating in the Sweepstakes and/or accepting any prize, Entrants grant Nationwide permission to use their name, likenesses, and image in connection with the Sweepstakes for purposes of internal promotion purposes, without further compensation to the entrant, unless prohibited by law.

3. Drawing.

Nationwide will choose the winner from all eligible entrants through a random drawing on October 14, 2026, and notify the winner via email on October 16, 2026. If a winner is not eligible for any reason, including firm eligibility restrictions, or if Nationwide cannot contact the

winner, the winner's prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner may be selected. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

4. Prizes.

(a) Award. The winner will receive one (1) ticket to an NFL game. Food and beverage service will be available starting 2 hours prior to the game and will continue until the game concludes. Ticket prices vary by stadium. Average Retail Value \$600.

(b) Expenses and Taxes. Prize winners are responsible for any expenses incurred in connection with the prize (includes travel, lodging, food and beverage, and any other incidentals, etc.) No substitution or transfer of prizes is permitted, except that Nationwide reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if an offered prize is unavailable. All federal, state and local taxes on prizes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Prize details not set forth herein are at the sole discretion of Nationwide.

(c) Legal Documents. If requested, winners must execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release, and (where legal) Publicity Release within 3 days of notification. Failure to do so may result in disqualification, forfeiture or award to an alternate winner.

5. General Rules

5.1. Applicable Laws. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. The Sweepstakes is void where prohibited by law. The prize winner may receive an IRS Form 1099 form for the value of their prizes. Entrants agree to be bound by the Official Rules and the judges' decisions, which are final and binding on all matters relating to Promotions.

5.2. No Responsibility. Nationwide and each of its respective affiliates, subsidiaries, parent corporations and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, employees and agents are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate entry information, theft, tampering, destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries; printing or other errors; and any entries or mail which are late, lost, delayed, incomplete, misdirected, stolen, mutilated, illegible, postage-due, or any combination of the above.

5.3. Nationwide's Rights. Nationwide can void any entrant's entry who it believes has attempted to tamper with or impair Promotion administration, security, fairness or proper play. Nationwide reserves the right to modify, suspend or terminate the Promotion if necessary due to circumstances beyond Nationwide's control. If the Promotion is terminated early, the judges will select the winners from all eligible entries received at the time of termination.

6. Governing Law and Disputes

- 6.1. Governing Law.** This Promotion is governed by and subject to the laws of the United States and the state of Ohio without giving effect to the conflict of laws rules thereof.
- 6.2. Disputes.** Except where prohibited, the entrant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved between the parties, and all claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Promotion or any prize awarded or the determination of the winner shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will the entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental or consequential damages or any other damages, including attorneys' fees. The entrant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.

Abbreviated Rules.

No purchase is necessary. The Sweepstakes begins on September 15, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. ET and ends on October 11, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. ET. The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of the forty-eight (48) contiguous United States and the District of Columbia. Void where prohibited by law, who: (a) are 18 years of age or have reached the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence at the time of entry, whichever is greater, and (b) are legally able to work in the United States and are policyholder members of Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company.

9.1.
