## Investment Strategy from investment's prospectus

The investment seeks long-term growth of capital. The fund invests all of its assets in the Class 1 shares of the Global Growth Fund (the "Master Global Growth Fund"), a series of American Funds Insurance Series, a registered open-end investment company. In pursuing its investment objective, the Master Global Growth Fund invests primarily in common stocks of companies around the world that the Master Global Growth Fund's investment adviser believes have the potential for growth. The Master Global Growth Fund will allocate its assets among securities of companies domiciled in various countries including the United States and countries with emerging markets.

## Category Description: World Large Stock

World large stock portfolios invest in a variety of international stocks that are larger. World-stock portfolios have few geographical limitations. It is common for these portfolios to invest the majority of their assets in developed markets, with the remainder divided among the globe's smaller markets. These portfolios typically have 20%-60% of assets in U.S. stocks.

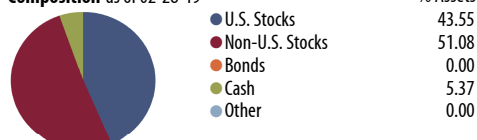

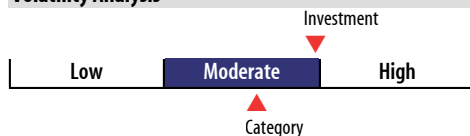
### Composition as of 02-28-19
