Investment Strategy from investment's prospectus

The investment seeks income primarily, and total return secondarily. The fund is a "fund of funds" that invests in affiliated and unaffiliated mutual funds representing a variety of fixed-income asset classes. It aims to provide diversification across more traditional fixed-income asset classes-U.S. government and investment-grade corporate bonds and mortgage-backed and asset-backed securities-in combination with less traditional asset classes, such as international bonds, emerging market bonds, high-yield bonds, commodities and loans with varying or floating interest rates.

Category Description: Multisector Bond

Multisector-bond portfolios seek income by diversifying their assets among several fixed-income sectors, usually U.S. government obligations, U.S. corporate bonds, foreign bonds, and high-yield U.S. debt securities. These portfolios typically hold 35% to 65% of bond assets in securities that are not rated or are rated by a major agency such as Standard & Poor's or Moody's at the level of BB (considered speculative for taxable bonds) and below.
